

BOOKLIST NOTES

MUSIC REQUIREMENTS: If your child has a music book and a recorder from 2023, there is no need for a replacement.

LOTE (Japanese): If your child has a Japanese book from 2023, there is no need to purchase replacements. It is likely that children will only need one blue lined exercise book over the years of primary school Japanese lessons. Occasionally children may participate in Japanese activities that will have some additional cost (e.g. cooking). Details will be forwarded to parents at the appropriate time.

TARGETTING MENTAL MATHS: There is a class level listed on the booklist, however if you child requires a different level the teacher will let you know in advance. When ordering please select the class level to order the book then indicate in the notes section of the order the level that you require.

MACQUARIE SCHOOL DICTIONARY 3RD ED: This can be carried through from Year 3 to 6.

HEADPHONES (compatible for use with iPad and computer): All headphones, Prep – Year 3, must have a single jack. Please send headphones to school named in a snap lock bag. For **Year 4 to 6** the headphones must have a microphone for multimedia use and have USB connection. If your student's 3.5mm jack headphones have a microphone you can purchase an adapter for converting the 3.5mm jack to USB from Mackay Office Products Depot. You will find this under the items purchased prior year section.

LIBRARY BAG: All students in Prep to Year 4 need a **red** Northview School library bag - available at the school office. Students in Prep, Yr. 1 & Yr. 2 also need a **green** library bag for homework. They can be re-used year to year. Cost \$20.00 each.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC, SPORTING TEAMS, EISTEDDFOD PERFORMANCES, and EXTENDED LEARNING: There will be additional costs for these activities. You will be invoiced if your child is involved.

2024 RESOURCE SCHEME: In consultation with the P & C, we operate a Student Resource Scheme. Our Student Resource Scheme covers the cost of:

- Reading Eggs;
- Mathletics;
- Sound Waves Spelling;
- Photocopying instead of purchased texts;
- In class activities e.g. Art, Science, Cooking.

- **EXERCISE BOOKS – Please ensure you purchase good quality exercise books with a high GSM to prevent paper tearing.**
